Lean and Green - Challenges for the Ship Repair Industry in China

Synopsis: The general market trend is leading the Chinese ship repair industry to go “Lean and Green”. Lean manufacturing concept and Green manufacturing concept are fundamentally different systems. However they are highly complementary in many areas. This paper looks at the adaptation of a Process Performance Enhancement (PPE) methodology to achieve Higher Performance (Lean) Activities with Environmental Management System (EMS) (Green) Objectives.
