Half-Day Seminar on “Ship Management and Operation”

1. Title: “Ship Management”

Synopsis: Roles of various stakeholders, their commercial relationship and basic understanding of how the shipping business works financially. In short - Nuts and Bolts Versus Dollars and Cents!

Speaker : Mr. Laxman KUMAR, Fleet Manager, Wallem Shipmanagement Hong Kong
Mr. Laxman Kumar is a Marine Engineer and a member of HKIE. He joined Wallem Shipmanagement in 1985 as a marine engineer and grew with the organisation assuming positions of increasing responsibilities. Currently he is a Fleet Manager, managing a fleet of bulk carriers and directly reports to the Technical director. Wallem is a highly reputable name in Ship Owning, Shipmanagement, Shipbroking and Shipping Agencies in Asia and worldwide and manages over 270 ships that employs 6000 seafarers and about 650 office staff in 44 offices in 19 countries. The current position of Mr. Kumar demands cross-functional responsibilities in marketing, finance, administration, fleet management, and human resources.

2. Title: “Survival Craft at Sea”

Synopsis: The topic of Survival Craft at sea would contain various kinds of on-load release mechanism including its hooks and release resetting systems, common deficiencies and measures taken by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) to prevent the lifeboat accident and consists of findings from last concentrate inspection campaign (CIC) on lifeboat launching arrangement during September to November 2009.

Speaker : Mr. C.Y. FONG, BEng (Hons), CEng, MHKIE, Surveyor of Ships / Port State Control, Marine Department, HKSAR Government

3. Title: "Port State Control Inspection"

Synopsis: The topic of Port State Control (PSC) Inspection consists of the most common issues that would be covered by PSC Officer and how they could be considered as detainable and some preventive means should be taken by the shipboard staff and the ship management company in order to prevent the result of ship detention with a large number of PSC deficiencies.

Speaker : Mr. C.Y. FONG, BEng (Hons), CEng, MHKIE, Surveyor of Ships / Port State Control, Marine Department, HKSAR Government

Mr. Fong graduated in Northumbria University (UK) and the Hong Kong Polytechnic. He is a Chartered Engineer and a member of HKIE. He had been a Marine Sea-going Engineer for ten years up to Chief Engineer post. Mr. Fong joined Lloyd's Register (HK) as Marine Engineer Surveyor in 1994 and had been serving there for eight years. He then joined Marine Department, HKSAR Government in 2002 and has been serving as Surveyor of Ship since then.
